



Tier II Reporting



WHAT: Reporting required under SARA Title III (Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act) and a component of CERCLA-Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act)

WHEN: Reporting of chemicals in excess of 10,000 lbs is required annually by MARCH 1st.

WHY: Purpose of the reporting is for the safety of first responders (e.g. firefighters) coming to a facility in an emergency

WHO: LEPC-Local Emergency Planning Committee

NDEQ-Nebraska Department of Environmental Quality

- Usually a letter is sent by NDEQ with your facility ID and Password to enter into their system.
 - If your facility has never reported, a hard copy is required the first year.

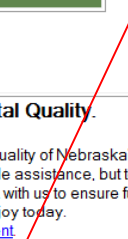


