Improve communication with our state and local agency partners


- Work with Erich Strach to meet/communicate with each state senator regarding NDOT projects affecting their areas.
- Have D1 superintendents contact each of the 13 county superintendents to discuss projects, programs and strategies.
- Have D1 supervisors contact each community in their jurisdiction to share and coordinate maintenance in their respective areas.

Utilize MDSS to maximize winter operations efficiencies

- Verify proper installation of all MDSS systems in each vehicle. Correct deficiencies.
- Train maintenance staff on system functions and making adjustments to keep the system working and providing desired feedback.
- Use data to maximize efficiency of material applications and minimize waste.

Develop the Construction Engineering Program for the district including the Lincoln South Beltway

- Organize the team of trained, certified staff and coordinate assignments to administrate all work produced on all projects.
- Coordinate with the assigned contractor to coordinate logistics for the project. Acquire/maintain necessary equipment.
- Deliver timely certified results to insure prompt and accurate payments in compliance with specifications.
- Make significant progress on completion of projects through the final process.
- Hire, train and maintain an efficient productive staff.

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2023 PRIORITIES

- Communicate construction projects to impacted communities through pre-construction meetings, message boards, press releases, one-on-one media briefings, senator briefings and information sheets and handouts.
- Facilitate and participate in meetings involving internal and external partners throughout the project encouraging impacted stakeholders to attend.
- Use surveys to get feedback from customers for process improvement.
- Develop a project community plan specific to the South Beltway, US-77 Wahoo to Fremont, N-92 four-lane to Omaha, and East Beltway in Lincoln.
- Look for participation opportunities with local communities to share our plans, get ideas and constructive feedback.
- Participate in community college and high school job fairs and career days to talk about the highway construction industry and opportunities at NDOT.
- Participate in school-sponsored or community-sponsored programs for younger kids to learn about the work that NDOT does (e.g., touch-a-truck).

INTERNAL/EXTERNAL COLLABORATION

- Communications Internal collaboration in holding public information meetings on projects and creating strategic communication handouts for engagement meetings.
- **HR** Internal collaboration with coordinating the proper training for winter operations.
- **Liaison Services** Internal collaboration with liaison services in updating superintendents on policy changes.
