



## **2023 GOALS**

- Increase the percent of lane miles in good condition to 97% by December 31, 2023.
- Meet with a different city, county or contractor at least once each month.
- Reduce the 3-year average cost per lane mile for surface maintenance and construction to \$16,000 by December 31, 2023.
- Meet with employees at different shops or offices at least once every other week.

### **2023 PRIORITIES**

- Communicate construction projects to impacted communities through pre-construction meetings, radio updates, press releases, handouts, information sheets and mailers.
- Facilitate and participate in meetings involving internal and external partners throughout a project's lifecycle.
- Use surveys to get feedback from customers for process improvement.
- Look for participation opportunities with local communities, organizations, and elected officials to share our plans, get ideas and constructive feedback.
- Participate in community college and high school job fairs and career days to talk about the highway construction industry and opportunities at NDOT.
- Participate in school-sponsored or community sponsored programs so younger kids can learn about the work we do.
