## Ingredients

1/2 cup oleo  
1 cup sugar, 1/2 tsp salt  
2 eggs, 1 cup sour cream  
1 tsp baking soda  
1 tsp baking powder  
2 cups flour

**Topping:** 1/2 cup brown sugar  
1/4 cup white sugar  
1t cinnamon
